To launch a competitive entrance examination into the **First year of the Professional Bachelor's Degree in Functional and Social Rehabilitation** at the Higher Institute of Applied Psycho-Pedagogy of Douala, under academic mentorship of The University of Maroua for the **2025-2026** academic year.

Mindful of Order No. 80/0263/MINESUP of 03 October 2008 to authorise the opening of courses preparing for foreign diplomas in higher education private institutes;
Mindful of Circular No. 13/0003/MINESUP,CAB/DAUQ/DAJ of 22 October 2013 relating to procedures and conditions for the academic mentor ship of HEPPI;
Mindful of letter No. 13/07893/L/MINESUP/DDES/ESUP/OAGS of 18 November 2013 on the agreement in principle for the establishment of the Higher Institute of Applied Psycho-pedagogy (ISPPA);
Mindful of Order No.14/0034/MINESUP/SG/DDES of 11 March 2014 on the agreement to establish a higher education private institute;
Mindful of letter No. 14/0420/MINESUP of 09 July 2014 to establish conditions for creation and operation of higher education private institutes;
Mindful of the Framework Agreement between The University of Maroua (UMa) and the Higher Institute of Applied Psychopedagogy signed on 30 April 2024;
Mindful of the constitution of the Higher Institute of Applied Psychopedagogy (ISPPA);
Mindful of Decision no. 18250145/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 07 April 2025 fixing the timetable for entrance examinations into establishments of the State Universities of Cameroon and schools under the academic supervision of MINESUP, for the academic year 2025-2026;

HEREBY DECIDES:

Article 1: A file study competition is currently under way at the Higher Institute of Applied Psychopedagogy of Douala. The competition is intended to recruit thirty (30) students into the first year of the Professional Bachelor in Functional and Social Rehabilitation. The following branches are open for the **2025-2026** academic year:

Article 2: The competition is open in a single session to all Cameroonian holders of Baccalaureate all series or *GCE-AL*.

Article 3: (1) International applicants from CEMAC countries that have ratified the texts relating to the national treatment of students and who have the same academic requirements may be admitted subject to availability.

(2) International candidates from outside the CEMAC contribute to the training costs, the amount of which is set by a specific text.

Article 4: An application file must comprise the following documents:

- An application form available at The University of Maroua Branch in Yaoundé, the registrar's office of the ISPPA, the Registrar's office of the Faculty of sciences at The University of Maroua, on the MINESUP website: <https://www.minesup.gov.cm>, and on The University of Maroua website: <http://www.univ-maroua.cm>
- A certified photocopy of the birth certificate not more than three (03) months old;
- An motivation letter;
- A detailed Curriculum Vitae ;
- Photocopies of Terminale and Premiere report cards;
- Certified copies of Probatoire or GCE-OL, and Baccalaureate or GCE-AL;
- A certified photocopy of Baccalaureate or GCE-AL, or any Degree recognised as equivalent by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, no more than three (03) months or any certified proof of success to one of these examinations;
- A medical certificate of physical and mental fitness testifying that the candidate is apt for higher education studies, issued by a medical doctor of the public administration;
- A receipt issued up on payment of fifty thousand (50 000) CFAF as registrations, issued by Société Générale Cameroun (SGC), bank code: 10003, account number 06191404596, key :09. No other payment mode will be accepted;
- A self-addressed A4 envelop, stamped appropriately;
- Four (04) passport-size photographs (4X4).

Article 5: Candidates with foreign degrees must provide either an official certificate of equivalency or the receipt for the deposit of the equivalency request issued by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education. However, their final admission, the awarding of their degree, and/or proof of success upon completion of their studies can only be obtained upon presentation within the time frames by the relevant authority, a document attesting to the degree's equivalent, and a document obtained by the candidate's care at the Ministry of Higher Education.

Article 6: All complete applications must be submitted to The University of Maroua branch in Yaoundé, the registrar's office of the ISPPA at Douala or to the Registrar's Office of the Faculty of Sciences of The University of Maroua, no later than Tuesday January 30th 2026.

Article 7: The concour will be done through the study of candidate files in February 03rd 2026. This note will be established based on the following criteria:

- a) The candidate's age;
- b) The number of years spent in high school;
- c) Report cards of premiere and terminal
- d) Results of the Baccalaureate or GCE/AL and Probatoire or GCE/OL.

Article 8: (1) After reviewing, the jury compiles a list of candidates for admission in alphabetical order for each speciality.

(2) Under no circumstances may admission be deferred from one academic year to the next.

(3) The final results are published through a press release by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education.

Article 9: The Jury referred to in the above article 8 is subjected by a text issued by the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education

Article 10: The competition fees referred to in the article 4 above are non-refundable.

Article 11: The Rector of The University of Maroua, the Director of University accreditations and quality and the Founder of the ISPPA are responsible, each in his sphere of competence for the implementation of this Decision which will be registered and published wherever necessary.
